Koviak Elected to MTA Board of Directors

Delta Charter Township, Mich.—Burt Township (Cheboygan Co.) Supervisor Harold Koviak has joined the Michigan Townships Association (MTA) Board of Directors, after being elected to serve as District 5 director at the Association's 60th Annual Educational Conference & Expo, held Jan. 22-25, 2013, at the Detroit Marriott Renaissance Center.
