

Trail Etiquette

1. Have fun! Be considerate! Think safety!
2. Share the trail with wheelchair users, pedestrians, joggers, cyclists and equestrians. Motorized vehicles are not permitted.
3. Stay right. Yield to slower and to oncoming trail users. Alert others when passing.
4. Watch for traffic, observe all signs, yield or stop at crossings.
5. Stay on the trail. Respect property owners rights to privacy and quiet.
6. Pick up after your pets and animals. Dispose of trash in appropriate receptacles.

Attention Property Owners along Burt Lake Trail: Please encourage your service and construction workers to park on the shoulder of the road opposite the trail. The trail is not designed for heavy loads.
